SPECTACULAR GULL LAKE

There is plenty of room for boating sports and quiet corners for fishing. The natural areas give lots of room to explore through four-season pursuits that make it your escape from hectic urban life.

ENVIRONMENTAL

Meridian Beach's sensitive design creates a balance between nature and development. The inlet canal is a perpetual ecological reserve planted with bulrushes to provide habitat for fish, other aquatic species and varied bird life. All lots are fully serviced with piped drinking water and a sewer system with offsite tertiary sewage treatment. These eliminate some common cottage headaches associated with individual wells and septic tanks. The overall design reduces impact on the environment by maintaining Gull Lake's pristine natural shoreline.

PARKS AND TRAILS

A group of interconnecting trails and pathways provide opportunity for leisure and exploration throughout the community. Walking is popular with people gathering informally at scenic view points on the footbridges and at the marinas. Biking is a popular way to get around. Quads are not allowed in order to maintain a quiet environment.

LOT PURCHASE

You purchase your building lot direct from the developer. Early phases are sold out, but there are still excellent lots both facing the lake and canal. Lots are spacious, averaging 75 feet wide by 120 to 200 feet deep and always with a park, forest or green space behind. Lots are fully serviced with year round water, sewer, gas, power and telephone. Prices range from \$110,000 to \$205,000, including GST. More expensive lots include a boat slip on the canal.
